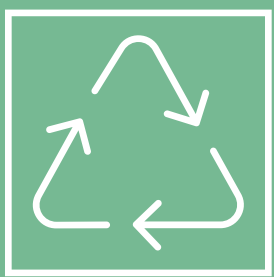
Welcome to the 35th edition of Affordable Art Fair NYC!

We've also got exciting programs and features each day of the fair – check out What's On so you don't miss out!

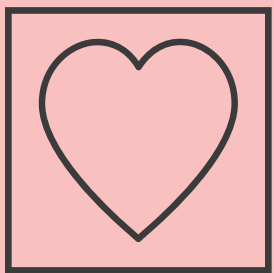

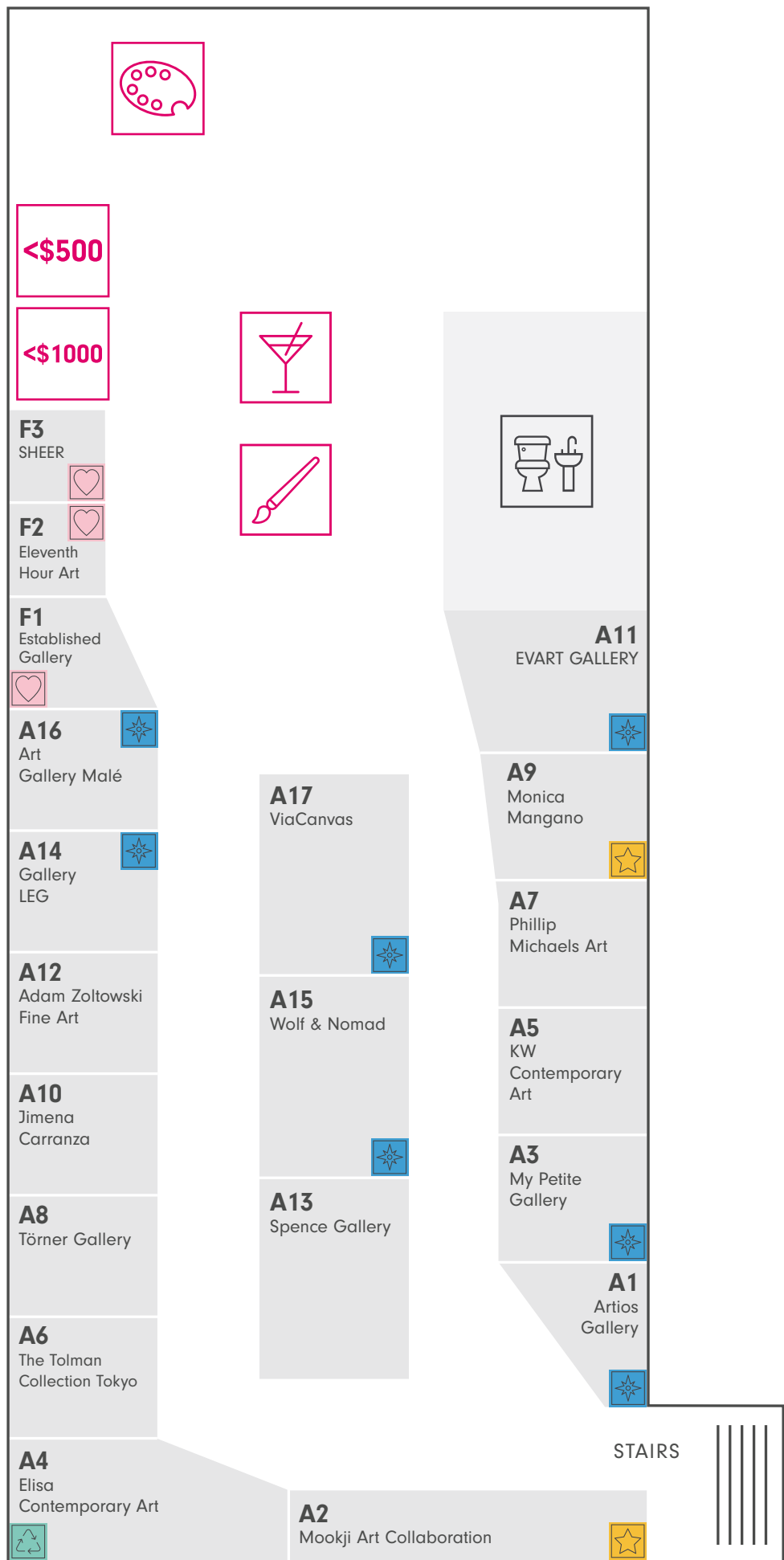
